WITH LITTLE INFORMATION OR DATA AROUND CAUSES, TREATMENTS, OR OUTCOMES, THYMIC CARCINOMA CENTER SEEKS TO PROVIDE EDUCATION, CANCER WELLNESS, AND ASSISTANCE TO PATIENTS AS WELL AS GRANTS FOR THE MEDICAL COMMUNITY WITH THE SOLE FOCUS OF FINDING BETTER TREATMENTS AND A CURE FOR THYMIC CARCINOMA.

Thank you for making 2022 yet another remarkable year for Thymic Carcinoma Center! This year marked a full year of providing needed services and programs for patients and their caregivers as well as investing in needed biomedical research for our cancer. Our dedicated staff, Board of Directors, and volunteers have done an incredible job at expanding our outreach while strengthening our programs and services. At Thymic Carcinoma Center we say, "It's not just about cancer, it's about HOPE" and what we mean is that we want our members to get the best doctors, treatments, and support to live healthy and happy lives.

We have been able to implement both member assistance and programs delivered directly to our growing members that are increasing at 18% year over year and accomplish our goals in 2022.

A few program highlights include: Establishing our Cancer Wellness Program; Funding a biomedical grant for \$240,000 to develop new cell lines for better treatments and efficacy of treatments; Implementing our Patient Assistance Program to provide financial travel assistance for those patients that need to travel for their trials, procedures, or treatments; Conducted fundraisers in Boston, Kansas City, and Cary, North Carolina that raised over \$100,000 to fund many more needed programs and research for Thymic Carcinoma.

Our ongoing goal is to keep our overhead low while being patient-focused by increasing needed programs and research for our patients and caregivers, and this is where you truly make this possible! Thymic Carcinoma Center is more vital than ever due to our continually expanding community who have come together to donate their time, resources, and talent to support our mission.

This year alone, we worked with diverse types of corporate sponsors and had over 250 individual donors; volunteers logged over 1,200 hours; our Board of Directors has helped us dramatically increase our donor base, and our Advisory Board has assisted us in expanding our understanding of our cancer patients and their needs to fight cancer.

But thanks to you, our voice continued to be heard among needed doctors and researchers in need of doing more for our rare type of cancer. 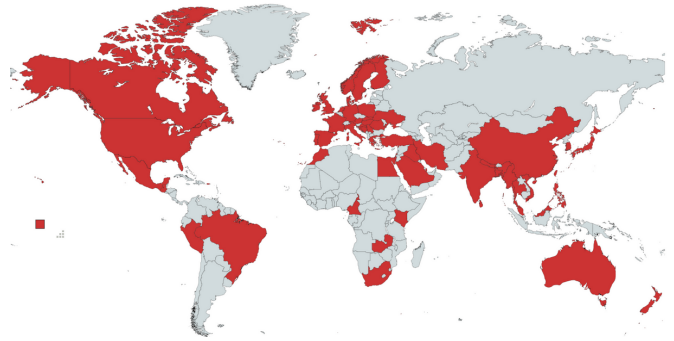

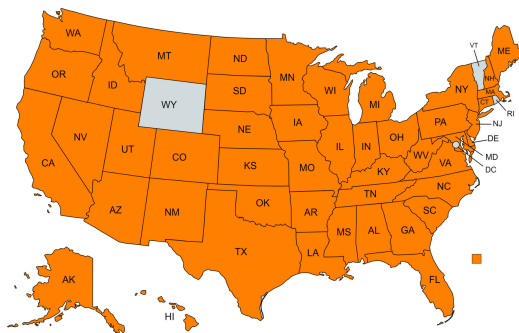

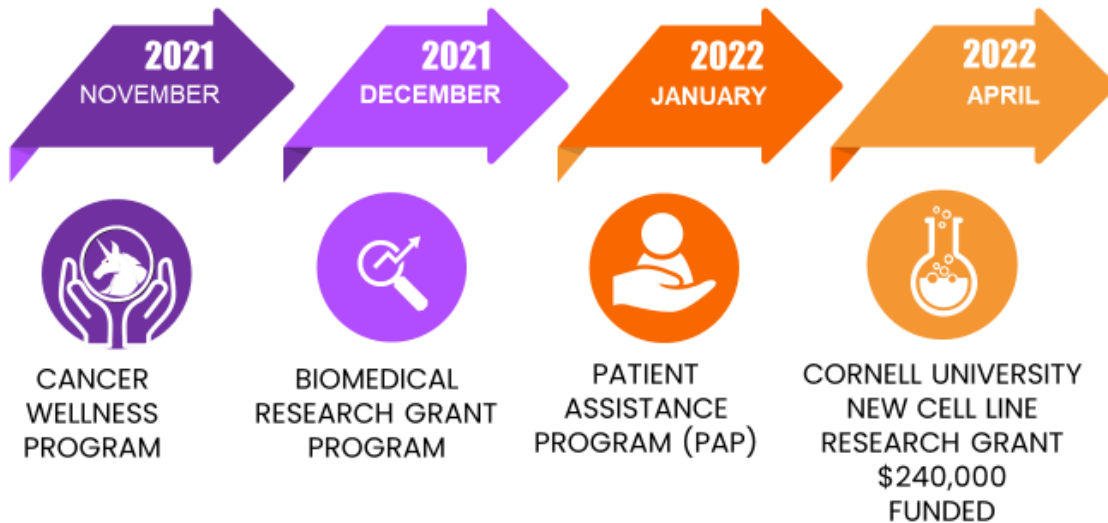

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

PATIENT ASSISTANCE

SINCE MAY 2022, THYMIC CARCINOMA CENTER HAS CONTRIBUTED \$10,000 TO PATIENTS ACROSS THE US TO RECEIVE TREATMENT AND PROCEDURES AT VARIOUS HOSPITALS. THROUGH THE EMILY KANE WELLNESS GRANT AND THE STEWART GOLD LIGHT & DARK GRANT, THIS MONEY WAS USED TO ASSIST PATIENTS WITH THEIR HOTEL, TRANSPORTATION AND FOOD EXPENSES.



MEDICAL RESEARCH

IN JUNE 2022 THYMIC CARCINOMA CENTER AWARDED A \$240,000 GRANT OVER A 2 YEAR PERIOD TO JOAN & SANFORD I. WEILL MEDICAL COLLEGE OF CORNELL UNIVERSITY LOCATED IN NEW YORK, NY FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF NEW MODELS OF THYMIC EPITHELIAL TUMORS (TET'S). THE RESEARCH WILL PROVIDE MODELS OF HUMAN THYMIC TUMORS, WHICH ARE ESSENTIAL FOR BETTER UNDERSTANDING THEIR BIOLOGY, IDENTIFYING UNIQUE TARGETS AND TESTING THERAPIES FOR THYMIC CANCERS.

CANCER WELLNESS

IN 2022 THYMIC CARCINOMA CENTER LAUNCHED ITS CANCER WELLNESS INITIATIVE TO SUPPORT AND UPHOLD OUR BELIEF THAT WHILE PROVIDING FINANCIAL SUPPORT TO PATIENTS AND MEDICAL RESEARCHERS IS ESSENTIAL, WE WANT TO ENSURE THAT WHILE PATIENTS ARE GOING THROUGH TREATMENT OR RECOVERY THAT THEY ARE SUPPORTED, HEALTHY AND HAPPY. 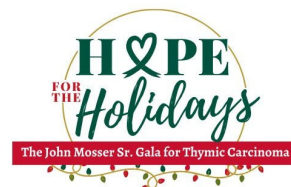

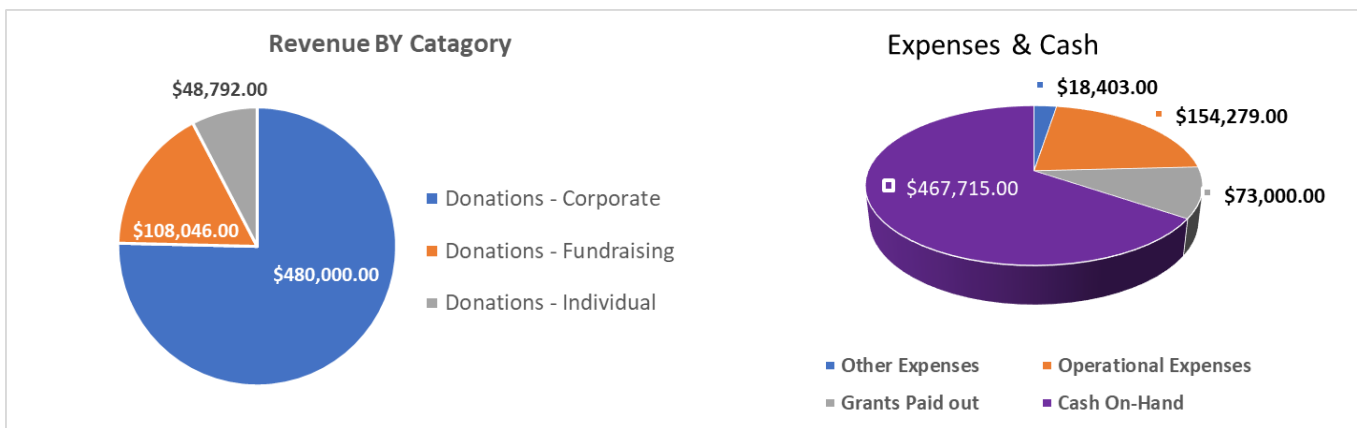

FINANCIALS

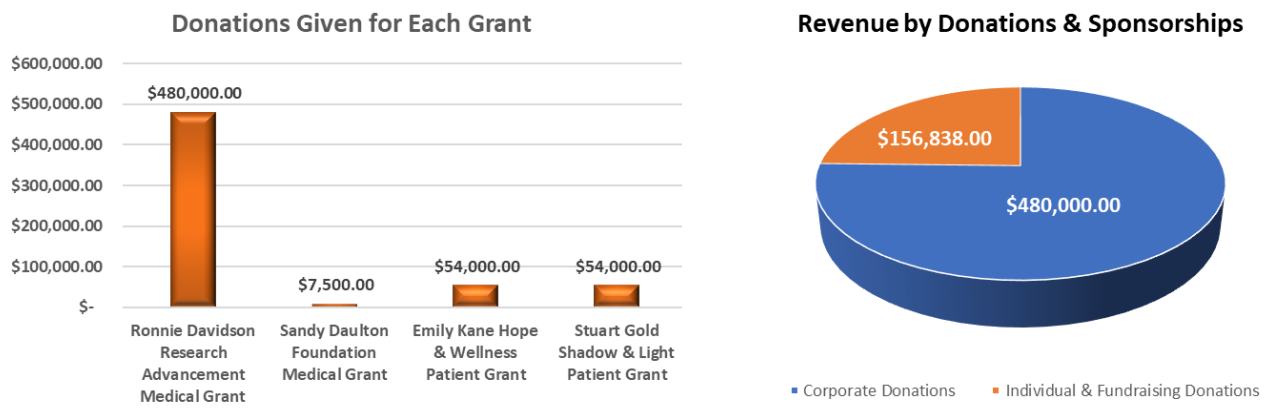

LOOKING AHEAD

Our mission remains to improving the lives of patients and caregivers as we continue to add additional programs for patient information, cancer wellness, and financial assistance. We will continue to evaluate and fund new biomedical research to find more targeted and advance therapies which and work towards finding a cure for this rare cancer. Our goal is to ensure that all of our patients are being supported to live healthy and happy lives.

In the year ahead, our goals for providing additional programs and fundraisers to make this a reality is as follows:



Establishing Certified Counseling Services

- Establishing a facilitator for a TC active patient group
- Establishing a certified counselor for 1-3 sessions for patients throughout their cancer journey (only if insurance is not covered)
- Establishing a facilitator for group grieving sessions.



BIOMEDICAL RESEARCH GRANT PROGRAM (open to International)

- Open up Research Grants to select International Research (Dr. Giaccone to assist in guidelines)
- Start Marketing directly to known TC Researchers for potential research studies
- Build a national or international Database that will utilize Data and Data Analytics as part of research for Genomic Research.



PATIENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (PAP)- Additional Programs

- Open up PAP for North America Patients and possibly select International patients
- Establishing a Patient Emotional Support Program with certified counselors and facilitators
- Bringing higher awareness of PAP Programs
- Assisting with Co-Pay or financing Genetic Testing for National Database if patients don't already have done this.



ESTABLISH ALLIANCES AND PARTNERSHIPS WITH TARGETED CORPORATIONS

- Establishing a partnership with 1-2 Airline Programs for Patients and Support companion
- Establishing a Partner Program with 1-3 National Hotel Chains for discounted rates for patients
- Identify 2-3 Corporate Sponsors for Fundraiser Events.
